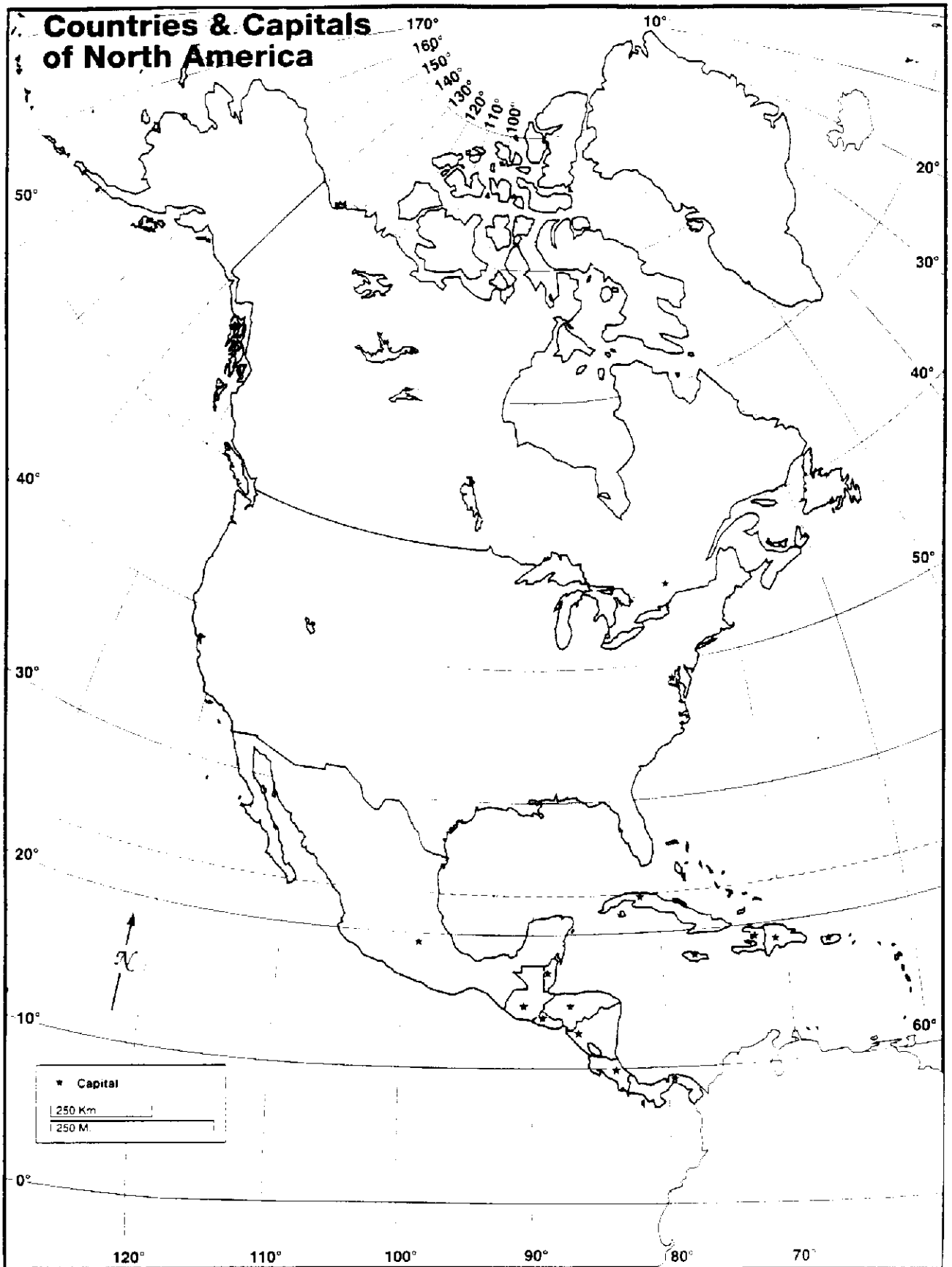


Figure 2. Countries and Capitals of North America

**Announcement Made At Clever Bridge Party  
At Home Of Bride-Elect's  
Parents**

OF interest to a wide circle of friends is the announcement of the approaching marriage of Miss Mildred Saxon, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. R. M. Saxon, of 3224 10th, to A. R. McCoy of Hankow, China, made known at a bridge party at the home of the bride-elect's parents Tuesday evening.

Miss Saxon, it was announced, will leave Port Arthur during the early part of October and will sail from Los Angeles, Cal., to Kobe, Japan, and will be married there early in November.

Following the wedding, Mr. and Mrs. McCoy will be in Kobe for several days, later going to Shanghai and then to Hankow, where Mr. McCoy is superintendent of the Texas Company plant.

Miss Saxon has been reared and educated here, and for the past five years has been connected with the executive offices of the school board.

Her fiance is well known here, and is the son of Mr. and Mrs. C. A. McCoy of Roswell, N. M. For the past two years he has been superintendent of the Texas Company's Hankow plant.

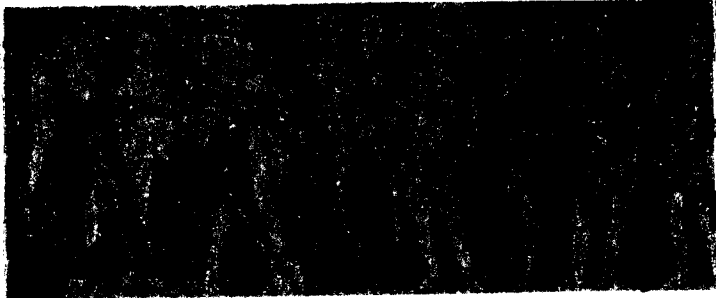
